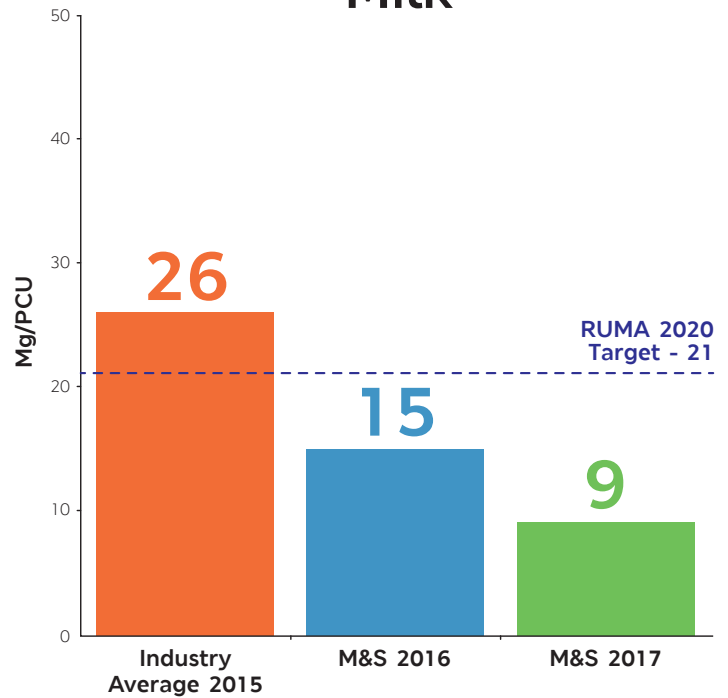


## Responsible Use of Antibiotics in Agriculture

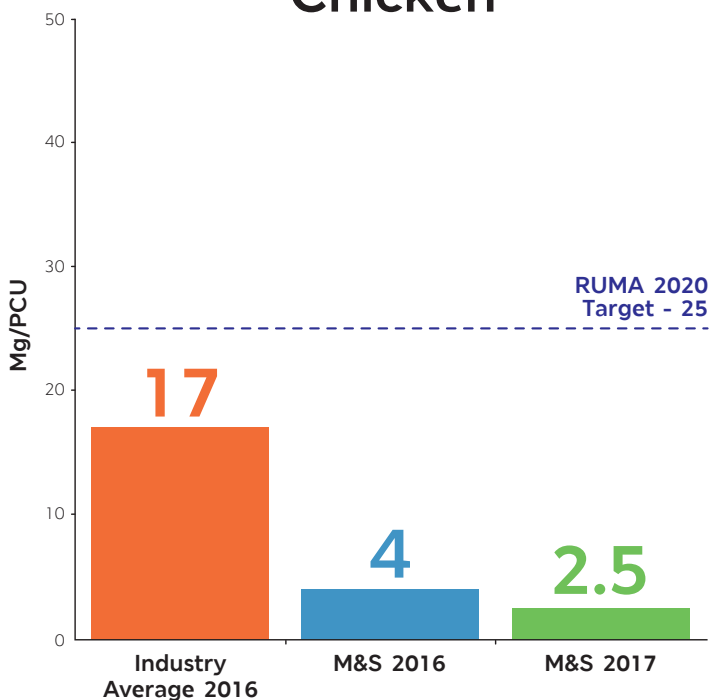

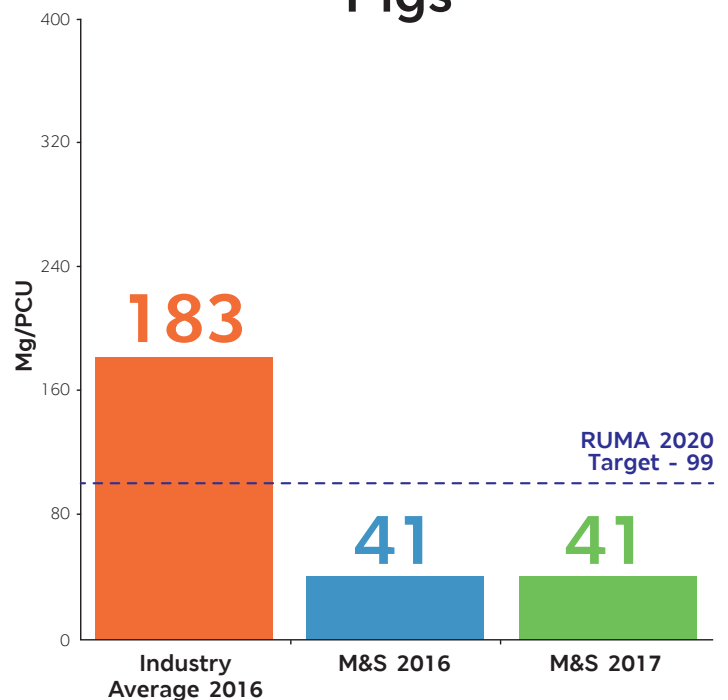
